Directions

From Highway 6, take Rock Prairie Road East (Opposite side of highway from College Station Medical Center).

Go approximately 1 mile, then turn left on Bird Pond Road.

Go approximately 1 mile, turn right at Lake Placid sign onto East Placid Drive.

Follow road around lake, bearing right.

Turn in at Bade sign at driveway.
